- ___ I will not try and be friends with people online if I don't know them in real life.
- ___ I will not say anything unkind or be mean to anyone online or in a message.
- ___ I will never use inappropriate language or call names online or in a message.
- ___ I will not give away any information over the internet, on a website, or in a message, including: my name, my birthday, home address, name of my school, my age, phone number, or email address unless my parent is with me and says it's okay.
- ___ I will not use a credit card to buy anything online. This includes an iTunes account. Internet purchases are for my parents only.
- ___ I will not download music, games, or software without my parents' permission, even if it says it is "free."
- ___ I will not give out any of my passwords or login information to anyone other than my parents, even my best friends.
- ___ I will keep personal conversations with my friends to real life.
- ___ I will stick to the time limits set by my parents and will not argue when asked to turn off the computer/iPod/iPad.
- ___ I will not create accounts or profiles on a website, even if it is free or for school, without my parents' permission.
- ___ I will stop communicating on the internet or messaging AND tell my parents if a conversation gets rude, uncomfortable, or threatening in any way.
- ___ When pop up ads come up, I will not click on them and will only close them using the X button.
- ___ When interacting with other people online, I am aware that:
 - ___ People are not always who they say they are
 - ___ People do not always tell the truth
 - ___ There is no such thing as privacy online

If I break these rules, even by accident, I know that my parents will not allow me to use the internet or text messages for a certain length of time. I also am agreeing that if I ever have a question about what to do online, I will ask my parents FIRST, before I do anything.
